Action Date, November 11th 1917 – Cambrai.

He displayed great courage and determination during the attack on Masnières on November 20th 1917. Although badly wounded at the 2nd Objective, he continued to advance carrying his Lewis gun to the third objective and brought it into action under very heavy machine gun and rifle fire in order to cover our final advance.

Distinguished Conduct Medal

London Gazette, 21st October 1918, and Supplement, 18th October 1918.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. During the period under review this man has proved himself a reliable and gallant soldier, and his devotion to duty has been remarkable on many occasions. He is an energetic and very efficient Lewis Gunner, and has rendered valuable services in that capacity.
