


Dear Mr. Strain.

I am a prisoner of war in Germany and am wounded in the right arm. I am in a good hospital and am getting good treatment. I spent a fairly good Xmas of course if I had been up out of bed no doubt it would have been better. However we must not complain. Have you heard from home lately. It is about two months since I last heard from it I am longing for some news from it now. I wrote home a fortnight ago but I dont know if they will get it as it is addressed with imelible pencil. It is alright if it desn't rub out it having such a distance to go. Now Sire you will certainly say this is not my writing but I have to write with my left hand and as I never wrote with my left hand before you will have to excuse me. Is uppose it is better to write with my left hand than not at all. Now Sir as soon as you get this please write home and tell Father where I am and give him my address, It is on the top of the paper. I would be very thankful with a parcel if you could send me one through the Red Cross Society. If you do ple send me a piece of soap and some cigarettes and whatever else you think suitable. If you can put my name in any fund for parcels you can kindly do so and I will be very thankful. Please remember me to all the family. Now Sir I think I have said about all for resent. So wishing you every success. I am yours sincerely GEORGE POMEROY.

P.S. When you write father tell him not to warry about me for I am getting good treatment. Tell him to send me aparcel through the Red Cross Society. Tell him to find out how they send parcels to prisoners and be sure and send me some cigarettes and scap.


