Dear Mrs. Bond:-

I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 2nd March addressed to the Prime Minister. It is noted that you are applying for furlough for your son, Private Levi Bond; and I am directed to say that under the present War Office regulations, it is not possible for furlough to be granted. Only men who are being returned for discharged can be repatriated under present conditions. One of the chief reasons for this being the shortage of available transports. It is difficult, even, to arrange transportation for men who are being repatriated for discharge. And it is regretted, therefore, that your request cannot be acceded to at the present time.
