Dear Sir:

When you were in St. John's, I promised you that I would look up your file and see if there was any record of your having received treatment in hospital during your War Services. I have now to report that your papers show that you were admitted to the sixth General Hospital at Rouen Island on February 18, 1919, suffering from Influenza. You were later admitted to the Mile End Military Hospital, England, on March 3rd, 1919, suffering from Bronchitis, and were discharged from hospital on March 19. You consequently returned to Newfoundland and were discharged under demobilization on July 11th, 1919, on category A-1, The notation being made that you were complaining of no disability.

If you wish to make a claim for pension, it will be necessary for you to provide Medical evidence to show that your present disability Tuberculosis is connected with your War Service, and in order to assist your case, you would have to produce Medical evidence to show that you were treated for this condition, soon after your discharge from the Army.

If you can produce the evidence as stated above, I would be glad to take your case up for you.
