Reference your reply to my No. 3427/21: As stated in O. C. "D" Co's letter, 1/5/16, Pte. Power wishes all payments due on account of his allotment per K. 2158 to be cancelled from the original date of commencement and superseded by K.4085. Stoppages have been made in his Pay account from 1/9/16, but since no date of commencement is stated on form K. 2158 none could be advised to you. It is observed that this Soldier arrived in U. K. with "C" Co. 4/9/16, and possibly certain deductions may have been made in his account before embarkation for this Country, which are not known in this office, hence my request to you to advise date of commencement of K.4085, which cancels K.2158 retrospectively from the date of the first stoppage in his Company Pay Book, if any, which should be known to you. 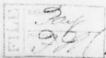

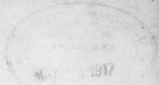



I have the honour to bring before the attention of the Pensions & Disabilities Board the case of the above mentioned soldier. Pte. Power was reported missing on 14th April, 1917 and later presumed killed on the same date. He had his allotment current payable to his sister Mrs P. Jackman of <sup>42</sup> 34, Williams St., of 70/- per day and the last payment of allotment was paid at the end of November.

Pte. <sup>Power</sup> Jackman had two young brothers who were both at Mount Cashel before he enlisted. Both father and mother are dead, one boy age 14 years is stated to be mentally deficient and the other age 15 years has just had an operation in the hospital and had one leg amputated from the hip (tubercular). Mrs Jackman realizes that as the allotment was payable to her and as Mr. Jackman is alive she is not entitled to pension or allotment that she was receiving might be expended for the benefit of these two young brothers.

The case is now brought before your attention to see if it is possible to have a pension allowed in favour
