I am in receipt of your telegram of 22nd March concerning No. 3440, Private C. Pym. No reply has been received to my letter of Jan. 31st concerning this soldier. For your information I would state that a telegram received from the Pay & Record Office, London on Feb. 8th states that the 3rd Echelon, Roush asks the correct age of this soldier, who was stated to be under age. This Office replied on Feb 9th stating that Private Pym would be 17 years old on 7th March, and that his birth certificate was forwarded by mail on 31st January. Although no communication has been received, I think it is fairly certain that this soldier would have been transferred to the Depot at Winchester by this time.

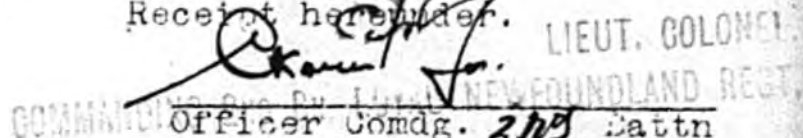

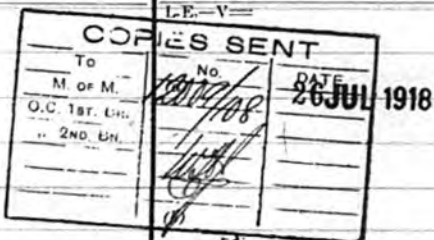

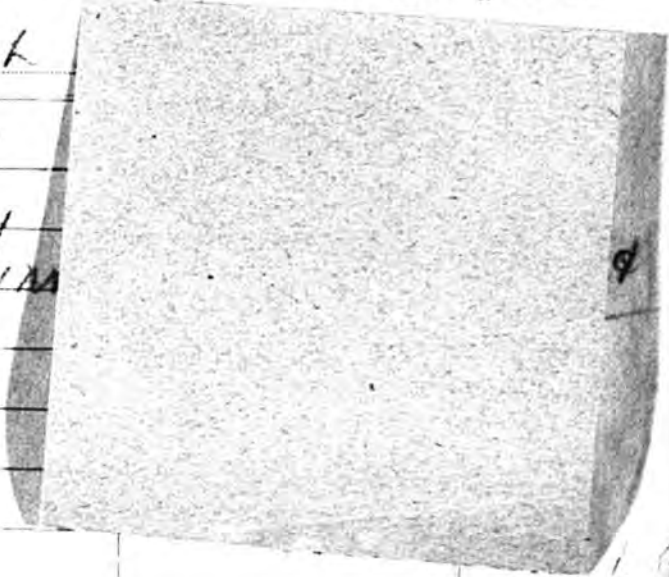
