INFLUENZA. The results of recent investigations into the efficacy of inoculation as a preventative against influenza are so encouraging that the G.O.C. in-chief considers that it should be given a trial in this command. It is proved beyond doubt that influenza vaccine raises the bodily resistance of presumed healthy men and so diminishes the severity of the attack and liability of complications such as pneumonia.

In view, therefore, of the notable increase of the disease during the past ten days, the G.O.C. in-chief would urge that G.Os. give every encouragement to their M.Os. to induce their men to submit to inoculation.

A plentiful supply of vaccine is available at the School of Army Sanitation, and indents from M.Os. incharge Units will receive immediate attention. (M).
