Peter Randell, Pte. Reg. No. 1276,

assigned to me an allotment as authorized on Form K No 1257, under date of April 12th. 1915. I received the allotment from June the 8th. 19 15 to March 15th. 1916, then the payments ceased. On October the 9th. 1917, my brother was killed in action, and I received a final payment of \$ 27.10 March 27th. 1919. During the eighteen months before my brother's death I received no money whatever. I am therefore anxious to learn of the disposition of the money assigned to me during the eighteen months prior to my brother's death. There is no record on **his** pay-books of his having drawn any money whatever during **t**he nine months previous to his death.

Will you do me the kindness to look this matter up, and advise me as soon as possible

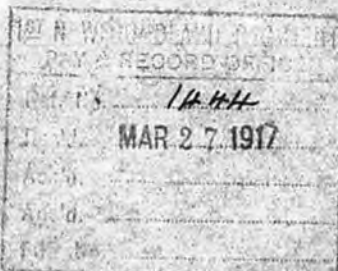
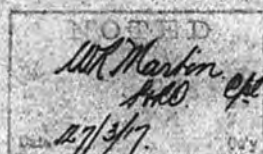
