I have your letter written to the Minister of Militia and have communicated with the Medical Officer at the Depot with regard to your case.

He informs me that the undescended testicle is "in the canal", i.e. it is half way down from the abdomen. This condition prevents your acceptance for Military service, even in the Forestry, because of the exposed position of the organ, rendering it liable to sharp pressure against the underlying bone.

The operation for its removal is not a serious one, and should you have it performed we shall be glad to accept you for service after a short period of convalescence.

If you decide to have it performed I shall be glad to arrange for your admission to Hospital.



