801, Opl. H.R. Raynes Newfd R.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. When his company was held up in front of a road by rifle fire, he with two others went out on their own initiative, crossing from shell hole to shell hole, and finally getting in rear of the road, where they bombed out dug-outs containing two or three men each. They killed about nineteen of the enemy and then signalled for their company to advance .

## Descriptive Return of a Soldier Discharged on Account of Disability
