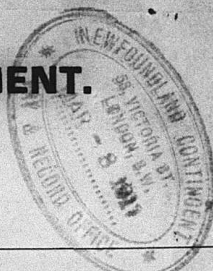

Postal Services

With reference to your letter 10/2/17 on the subject of a parcel addressed to No. 1873, Cpl. Levi Reid, records show that the parcel referred to was received at this office on 22/12/16, and together with a number of others was handed over in sealed bags to the Army Post Office for delivery to the addressee in accordance with customary process.

All postal matter received here, after being re-directed, is thus taken over by the Army Postal authorities, and further responsibility of this office naturally ceases when mail matter passes out of its control.

In a number of cases where complaints of non-deliveries have been received, it has been found that parcels etc. had reached their destination by the time the enquiries had been put through, and it is possible that this may also prove to be only an instance of delay rather than actual loss.

The nature of the casualty is required for telegraphing details overseas. If the details given are insufficient, reference back to the hospital for further information is rendered necessary. The following instructions should therefore be carefully followed in all Colonial cases:
