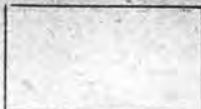



Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of June 2nd in relation to the case of Ex.Pte. Fred Randall of Twillingate, I would state for your information that this soldier enlisted on September 28th 1915, and was discharged on the 19th of July 1917 without having been in a theatre of war although he had service in England. This man was entitled to one payment of \$70.00 which was mailed to him at Twillingate on November 26th 1919. For a man with his length of service to receive a higher scale of War Service Gratitude it would be necessary for him to have had active service in a theatre of war or to have been on the strength on the 11th of November 1918 (the date of the Armistice)

I regret that no further payment was due.
