



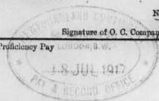

In reply to your letter of July 15th, enquiring concerning the military record of No. 2163 Sidney Randall, I would report as follows:

This man enlisted on the 23rd February 1916; shortly after his arrival in Syr, Scotland, he reported sick with asthma. He was not sent to a theatre of war but was returned to this country about the middle of 1917 and was retained on Light Duty. He was promoted L/Cpl. from 1st July, 1918 and Corpl. from 1st July, 1919, and was demobilised on 23rd May, 1920. During the latter part of his service he was employed in the Pay Office of this Dept. After his discharge he was being treated in hospital here from 22nd May, 1920 to 20th August, 1920, during which period he was completely disabled.
