We are favoured with your letter of the 6th. Section 40 of the War Pensions Act, provides that the pension of any female pensioner, who is found to be a common prostitute, or who openly lives with any man in the relationship of man and wife. without being married to him, shall be suspended, dis: ":continued or cancelled. This section brings within its scope women of two classes, and of two classes only, namely: - either "a common prostitute" or an unmarried woman "who openly lives "with any man in the relationship of man and wife". Admittedly. Mrs. Rideout has given birth to an illegitimate child, but the mother of an illegitimate child cannot be described as "a common prostitute". Similarly, the mother of an illegitimate child is not necessarily one who openly lives with any man in the relationship of man and wife. Mrs. Rideout has not been "found to be a common prostitute". Neither has she openly lived with any man in the relationship of man and wife, and accordingly. her/

her pension should be continued.

We venture to think, that the matter has not been carefully dealt with, because, in the letter from The Pension Commissioners, St. Johns, of April 10th, to our client, they state "as you were "found guilty of misconduct under Section 39 of The War Pensions "Act, the board is bound to cancel your pension." When that statement was challenged, the Commissioners then changed their position, and founded upon Section 40 of the War Pensions Act.

It humbly appears to us that it is not for the pensioner to establish that she does not fall under Section 40.(although, we think, we have demonstrated this clearly); on the contrary, it appears to us that the onus is unquestionably upon the Commission: ers, who propose to cancel the pension, to state fully and explicitly, the grounds upon which they base their decision, and we shall be glad to know what these grounds are.






