

But I am sorry to say that I do not think there is very much hope of him being alive, because if he was a "Prisoner of War" the fact would have been notified to us before this.

With reference to your inquiry whether your son was a Lance-Corporal, I beg to state that he was promoted to Lance-Corporal on the Field on 20-8-17 by Lieut.Colonel Hadow, C.M.G., who was at that time Commanding the 1st Battalion of The Royal Newfoundland Regiment.
