Re-Issue of Imperial War Badges.

Sir:-

In connection with the attached communication from His Excellency the Governor I have the honour topreport, that the last regulations in connection with the issue of Imperial War Badges provide, that any man whe has been accepted for service and has later been discharged on account of disability, is entitled to receive a badge.

In the case of #3191 Pte. George R.Roberts cited in His Excellency's letter, the only reason why this man has not received his badge is, that our supply has been exhausted. A further shipment has been ordered and is expected from London shorthy. As soon as it is received a badge will be engraved for Pte. Roberts and forwarded to him, as we have a record of his name as an applicant for one.

I had the settling of all that matter before I left Downing Street, but I have not a copy of the Regulations by me and I do not quite remember the details.

It has been brought up to me by the case of the man, George W. Roberts, who was discharged under No.3191 over a year ago. I am informed that he can only get work occasionally owing to his wound and that when he is at work he is being troubled with appeals to recruit. This is the sort of case with which I was familiar at Home, and I should like to do anything that is fair.
