Dear Major Montgomerie,

Last evening there was heard an application, No. 4576, Augustine Ryan, made by a young sister dated the 4th of October. The man was in Khaki, and the Tribunal consisting of Judge Kent, would not interfere, but recommended strongly the case to the consideration of the Military Authorities. There was no doubt about the bona fides. The neglect of the application ^{not} being made before was only want of knowledge as to what should be done, and following the advice of the Magistrate without ^{his} apparently knowing the circumstances of the case. At the instance of the Magistrate he reported for service and came to St. John's. He joined up about the 2nd. of October, and he put his application in on the 4th of October. I think his Regimental number is 6211. Perhaps he was put on the strength conditionally as I understand from Capt. Tait he did this ^{on some occasions}. If so you may be able to do something with him.

Augustine Ryan, of Salmonier, was attested yesterday, and is, I understand, at present at Barracks.

His sister came out with him to claim exemption on his behalf, and called at the office to see you this morning for this purpose. I have informed her that exemption cannot be granted as the man is in the Regiment -unless you would be agreeable to regard him as a conditional enlistment. She will call this afternoon for your decision.

The circumstances appear quite genuine: The father and mother are both dead, and Ryan (who has no brothers) is the sole support of two young unmarried sisters.
