In order that a satisfactory reply may be made to the enquirer, will you kindly cause the fullest investigations to be made in the matter and submit a report comprising information on the following points:-

- (1) There is no trace of any effects having been received here on account of Pte. Ryan. If none were recovered, can any reason for this be given?
- (2) Whether or not any personal effects were recovered from his Pack.
- (3) If effects were recovered and forwarded of what did these consist, to whom was the parcel addressed, on what date despatched and by what method. If forwarded by Registered Post, the Registered No. of the package and F.P.O. at which handed in should be given.
- (4) As this man is reported as "Missing" can it be assumed that his body was not recovered.

It is realised that owing to lapse of time it is very improbable that satisfactory particulars will now be forthcoming, but the enquiry having been received it is necessary to cause the fullest possible investigations to be made.
