The above mentioned Officer was before Medical Board on Tuesday night, and was recommended for sanitarium treatment and immediate discharge. Under these circumstances I do not feel justified in retaining him in the office to the possible detriment of his health.

Dear Seviour:-

I am in receipt of your letter of June 23rd, and have noted contents of same. As this is a matter for the Board of Pension Commissioners, I have forwarded your letter to them and have asked them to communicate with you direct.

Quite recently a committee of the G.W.V. A. had the matter of pensions brought before the Executive Government, and they have been promised a reply from the Executive Government by Thursday of this week. I am unable to state whether the Government intends to in any way alter the present pension regulations.

As regards the point raised by you, I know that it has been in the minds of the Pension Commissioners to ask for sanction of such a policy; that is, of placing a man while in hospital on regimental rates of pay and allowances. I hope your letter will enable them to come to some decision. I am very much afraid that, unless a general policy is adopted, they would not make an exception of any one case. I would suggest that you address a letter also to the Secretary of the G.W.V.A. (P.A. Brien), asking for information as to what they have been able to do in their representations to the Government.

I hope that you are feeling better and showing some improvement in your treatment at Kentville; and I should be very happy to hear from you once in a while as to how you are progressing


