Opinion of the Medical Board.

Notes.—(i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.



The soldier in question was before a Medical Board in London on the 30/10/17 where he was dealt with as a Dysentery case invalided while on active service. He was before a Medical Board at St. John's on December 19th, where he was recommended for discharge, this latter recommendation being based on his being under age.

This soldier was enlisted at St. John's, giving his age as eighteen years four months. He proceeded on active service to France in June, from which Theatre of War he was invalided in September 1917.

I submit for your consideration that the recommendation of the Medical Board should be based on the physical condition of this soldier, invalided while on active service.

The question of age is one on which a supplementary note could be made, and the matter would then be investigated and <sup>dealt</sup> with by the Medical Authorities.

In view of the fact that the soldier, on attest-

if the Medical Board received any confirmation of the statement now given as to age, other than the soldier's own verbal statement.

I make the above suggestion in view of the fact that the soldier has been on active service, and if discharged on this recommendation, would not be entitled to the War Badge granted to discharged soldiers who are found unfit for general service on the ground of Medical Unfitness.

The marginally noted man has been before the Standing Medical Board and they have found that he is still under the age when he should be admitted, though he has seen service in France.

I do not know that the Medical Board has the right to recommend Discharge for this reason. There is no medical reason for his discharge. You will doubtless make the matter a case for formal enquiry.

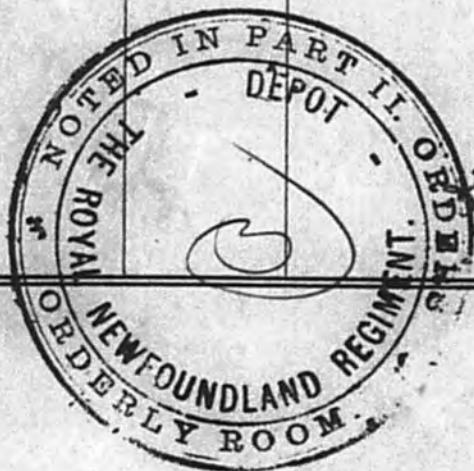
