When a soldier becomes noneffective, him effects are collected from the Unit with which he was serving, and from the Depot overseas, by the Secord Office, London, and are despatched this Department. Everything known to belong to the soldier concerned is included before shipment is made to this Department. Bothing is held out by this Separiment, but everything is forwarded to the Hext of Kin. Reverend Sir: With reference to his accounts, the Pay Office over-seas has to wait until the acquittance rolls are received from the Field Gashier through the Army Pay Office, and until his Pay Certificate and Fay-book are received from the Battalion in the Field, through he Butates Branch, the secount is then forwarded to this Department, and from this Department to the Separtment of Justice for Administration.
