Statement by 1226 Pte. J. Lyons, 1st. Newfoundland Regiment.

About 10 A.M. I was in C Post in the front line trenches and saw Pte. Prince with his rifle in his hand, cleaning it. I noticed that his rifle was pointing towards where some of us were sitting. Pte Seymour was doing sentry at the time and was standing near us; but before I could go over to make Pte. Prince point it the proper way, the rifle went off and killed Pte. Newman, and wounded Pte. Seymour in the leg.

About 10 A.M. on the 27th. inst. in C. Post in the front line trenches, and I handed 3566 Pte. J. Prince his rifle to clean, and sat down next to him while he began to clean it. Suddenly the rifle went off and I saw Pte. Newman fall to the ground badly wounded in the right shoulder, from which he died soon after. At the same time, Pte. Seymour reported that he was hit in the leg, and I saw where he was hit.
