





I respectfully beg permission to forward my protest on being super-seded for rank of Captain by Officers whose rank of Captain

dates from Dec. 31st.
I having been promoted to my present rank in Oct. 1915 whilst on Active Service, and I consider this unjust and contrary to any regulations, as unless as adverse report has been made by the Officer's C.O. his seniority must be taken into consideration. In the event of an adverse report on an Officer a copy of such must be passed to Officer concerned and should there have been such in my case, noccopy has been received by me.

In my application passed to you I stated that whilst attached to Staff of 29th Division, I was recommended by A.A.& Q.M.G. & G.O.C.

respectively.

I now request that reasons for my being superseded be forwarded me as quickly as possible, as I intend should they be other than for necessary military reasons or proved inability to hold said rank, to immediately take the matter to higher authorities for a ruling.






