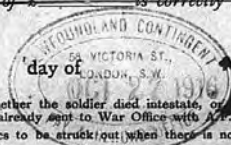

The bearer, Mr. Robert C. Sheppard, is an ex-soldier of the Newfoundland Regiment. He was invalided with a bullet in the groin which unfitted him for marching, but as he is a man of more than ordinary education and has had some seafaring experience, he thought it might be possible for him to get a Commission in the Canadian or British Naval Patrol Service. I gave him a letter this morning to Commander MacDermott, asking to consider him in this connection, but that officer understood that he was for the local patrol and told him, of course, that it was too late. I did not have that idea in view at all, but thought that perhaps he might get a naval sub-lieutenancy in some way, provided, of course, that his disability does not unfit him. I offered to give him a second letter to Capt. MacDermott or one to you, but he preferred the latter, so I send him along in the hope that you may be able to do something for him. If not, we propose to give him a course in navigation so as to fit him for a job in the merchant marine.
