Whilst no doubt your action was prompted by the best of intentions, such being liable to cause misunderstanding between H.Q., St. John's and this office, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to let me have a report of the circumstances and a copy of the telegram you sent.

I beg to inform you that the late Pte. L.M. Shortall, of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, was buried with full Military Honours, at Brookwood Cemetery on 4/5/18. The firing party and bugle party consisted of men from the South African Forces. The Service was conducted by the Rev. Father Mason. The coffin was covered with the Union Jack, and was drawn on a gun carriage; by representatives from the Dominions beyond the Seas. Pte. Shortall was buried in Grave No. 79839.
