

Bear Sir:-

Your letter addiessed to the Casualty Officer of July 9th has been duly received, with reference to the enquiry of this Department for information concerning certain members of the Regiment, of whom No. 2959 Ptc. Frank H. Simma in one.

I might say that I sent in this enquiry to endeavour to find out some further perticulars about the nature of death of soldiers referred to. You will note that my letter of of Sept. 16th. 1918 states that certain information was procured through the Red Cross Society operating in Berlin. In the other cases concerning which the enquiry is now made, it has now come to notice that there was no German field dressing station at Serenvillers, and no trace of any burying groundman be found. nor is such known to the regular inhabitants of that district. It is lelt that the Germans had supplied false information: and the mater has been referred to the War Office for investigation. The War Office authorities and the Imperial War Gaves Commission are making every endeavour to secure facts. Cher regiments besides with be effected also by the ultimate result of the enquiries: and this Department endeavouring to find out full available facts concerning the treatment of prisoners by the Germans in that particular

sector at that time; and I am hoping that some of the soldiers who faught in that section will be able to reply to my notice in the Press, and any information that comes to hand will be notified to you in due course.
