I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 27th Nov. and the attached documents respecting the case of the above mentioned soldier. Reference to the records of this soldier shows that he was recommended for discharge, owing to disability caused by wounds received on active service, by a medical board assembled on Jan. 12th, 1917. He was honourably discharged on Jan. 26th, 1917. A medical board was assembled 21st July, 1917, and another on 13th Oct. 1917 for the purpose of estimating his then disability for pension purpose. The last named board estimated his disability as NIL; but I would point out, made no recommendation. There is a statement on the Report Form made by the Approving Medical Officer which says: "Fit for re-enlistment", but the Medical Board is in no way responsible for that observation, and it would be outside their province to make such a recommendation. 

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 27th Nov. and the attached documents respecting the case of the above mentioned soldier. Reference to the records of this soldier shows that he was recommended for discharge, owing to disability caused by wounds received on active service, by a medical board assembled on Jan. 14th, 1917. He was honourably discharged on Jan. 26th, 1917. A medical board was assembled 21st July, 1917, and another on 13th Oct. 1917 for the purpose of estimating his then disability for pension purpose. The last named board estimated his disability as NIL, but I would point out, made no recommendation. Sir:-

I am desired by this Board to call your attention to the attached correspondence respecting the case of an-Private Brendan Sinnott, of the Newfoundland Regiment, and the reports of the Medical Boards in relation to this man which are also forwarded. You will note that he has been found by the Standing Medical Board to be suffering from no disability and to be fit for re-enlistment. This finding has been communicated to the District Officer commanding who, as you will notice, declines to take action on the matter.

Our Board therefore respectfully represents to you that in view of the fact that this man is physically fit, it is not calculated to stimulate recruiting for him to be employed in a clerical capacity in connection with the headquarters of the Regiment in St. John's, when a number of returned soldiers suffering from physical disabilities of a permanent character, but capable of doing such clerical work, are unable to find employment; and our Board strongly suggests that it might be desirable to have him replaced by some of these men in view of the obligation on the Colony to endeavor to do the best possible for those who have suffered loss of physical functions which limits them previously in their choice of occupations.
