



I find that the injury to this man was caused by the explosion of a Mills Bomb, thrown by himself while on Active Service in France. A Court of Enquiry was assembled on the Field on the 13th of October /16 and the proceedings were forwarded to the Brigadier General, Commanding 88th Brigade.

His findings is as follows:-

"I am of opinion that the occurrence was an accident paused probably through ignorance on the part of Private Small".

Under these circumstances the injury cannot be attributed to misconduct but must be considered as accidental and occurred while on Active Service.


