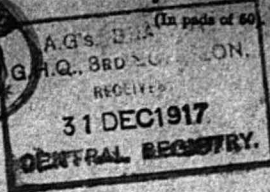

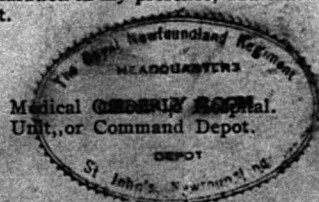



The above mentioned Officer has been detailed by this Department with the sanction of the Government to undertake the work in France and Belgium of marking and having registered of the isolated graves and bodies of Newfoundland soldiers and of having them collected into the Military Cemeteries.

2. A letter has been addressed to the Chaplain General's Department asking that Capt. Nangle be seconded for duty with the Royal Newfoundland Regiment for this special work and that he be given the acting rank of Major while so employed. The Chaplain General's Department has been requested to notify you of their sanction of this and I shall be glad if you would at once cable this office.

3. Capt. Nangle should be noted for pay ex. Newfoundland funds with effect from July 2nd at the rate of Captain, and if his acting promotion is approved, at the rate of Major from date of approval.

4. Capt. Nangle is authorized to make necessary expenditure in connection with the satisfactory carrying out of this work for which he will render statements to you. Letters have also been addressed to the Secretary War Graves Commission, the Director of Graves Registration and Enquiries, and to the Commission Nationale des Sepultures Militaires, asking their assistance and co-operation.

5. Capt. Nangle has instructions to report progress periodically and he will send his reports to you for transmission. Any important features are to be telegraphed, please, to avoid delay.

1. Capt. Nangle duly arrived and has been provided with requisite accommodation in this office, and also documents etc. regarding matters of which he is taking charge. Copies of:  
W.O. Letters NA/74 (Chaplains) 15/8/19 (A)  
Capt. Nangle's letter 20/8/19 (B) are enclosed.

2. From (A) para 1 he is not seconded but demobilised, and it would appear that he becomes an Officer in the Newfoundland Contingent. Under the circumstances Capt. Nangle thought it better to submit the position in writing and not telegraph. Presumably Capt. Nangle will receive Pay & Allowances as from 2/6/19 with rank of Major. (1). On arrival in this Country on Special Duty for the Newfoundland Government, I approached the various authorities and found I could carry out the work entrusted to me in a better manner if I gave up my present commission and was appointed under the Newfoundland Regiment; I was therefore demobilized from the Royal Army Chaplains' Department taking effect from the 2nd June, and suggest that I be gazetted to the Regiment from that date (with the rank promised, Major) and be appointed as

Director of Graves Registration & Enquiry,

(2) As regards allowance, I wish you would ask the Department in Newfoundland to grant me the same expenses as those previously given to Draft Conducting Officers to this Country, and Officers on various duties, namely \$10.00 per diem. This may look big, but when taken into account the high cost of living at Hotels, and continuous travelling about, the amount named will barely cover expenses. In France, now that the Officers' Clubs are closed, and it being impossible to draw rations, living will be much more expensive than perviously.

(3) For Sergeant Snow I recommend \$1.50 per day in London, as he may live quite well and cheap at a Soldiers' Hotel at that amount, and \$2.00 a day in France.
