I have your letter of the 10th inst. with regard to Mrs. Heary Snow, who is seeking assistance from the Patriotic Fund on account of her son Ptc. James Snow of The Royal Newfoundland Regiment.

Upon inquiry I find that Pte. Snow is making an Allotment of 50 cents per day, payable to his father, Mr. Henry Snow. This is not a case wherein assistance from the Patriotic and can be successfully applied for trather is it a case where Pte. Snow should increase the Allotment to his father. I would suggest that Pte. Snow Se written, and his mother's circumstances explained to him, and that he be requested to increase his Allotment to - say 50 or 60 cents per day.

With regard to the case of Mr. H. Russell, father of Royal Hawal Reservist Edward Russell, I would state that the reason why the payments from the Patriotic Pund have ceased, is because of the fact that on May 16th the sum of \$552.71 was paid Edward Russell on account of Augmentation of Pay. By recent ruling of the Patriotic Pund Committee it was decided that in all cases where sums had been paid on account of this Augmentation of Pay, the payments from the Patriotic Pund would cease.
