Dear Sir:

I have your letter of the 10th inst. with regard to Mrs. Henry Snow, who is seeking assistance from the Patriotic Fund on account of her son Pte. James Snow of The Royal Newfoundland Regiment.

Upon inquiry I find that Pte. Snow is making an Allotment of 50 cents per day, payable to his father, Mr. Henry Snow. This is not a case wherein assistance from the Patriotic Fund can be successfully applied for, rather is it a case where Pte. Snow should increase the Allotment to his father. I would suggest that Pte. Snow be written, and his mother's circumstances explained to him, and that he be requested to increase his Allotment to - say 50 or 60 cents per day.

With regard to the case of Mr. H. Russell, father of Royal Naval Reservist Edward Russell, I would state that the reason why the payments from the Patriotic Fund have ceased, is because of the fact that on May 15th the sum of \$532.71 was paid Edward Russell on account of Augmentation of Pay. By recent ruling of the Patriotic Fund Committee it was decided that in all cases where sums had been paid on account of this Augmentation of Pay, the payments from the Patriotic Fund would cease.
