There was no holding back so far as your son was concerned, for he was amongst the first who volunteered and we are proud to have such gallant young meneas well as such patriotic fallers and mothers, who so willingly give them up upon the call of Duty. Your boy's name will be inscribed upon the Roll of Honour and will be held in fragrant memory by all his countrymen. He did his best and gave his utmost for the cause of Liberty and, because of his life and death, the time has been brought nearer when Peace and Truth shall reign again upon the earth. In your sorrow you can look up and realize that he at least has reached the victor's crown of glory.
