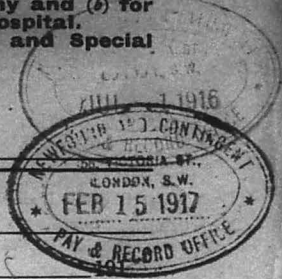

I notice by certain regulations published by your Department that payment of War Service Gratuity is being made and as I am not sure where I fit into the scheme. I write to you for information as to what steps I should take in the matter.

I enlisted Mar. 8th 1915 served in the Gallipoli Campaign and was discharged as unfit for service on May 23, 1917. Having served 2 years 77 days. My # was 1196. I receive a small pension #215 but received nothing by way of gratuity. I think, being one of the early campaigners I am entitled to some consideration at your hands over and above that now received, and shall be glad to be notified by you what course to take to secure any allowance made to such as I.

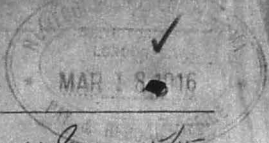
