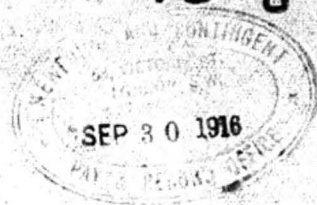

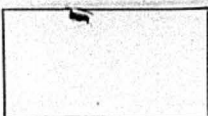

In admission here an explanation for appendicitis showed the chest wound to be communicating with abdomen. Further operations were necessary to drain the peritoneal cavity. The complication of ruptured intestine then necessitated closing of fecal fistula in ileum & intestinal anastomosis carried out. A final effort was made to clear out suppurating cavities

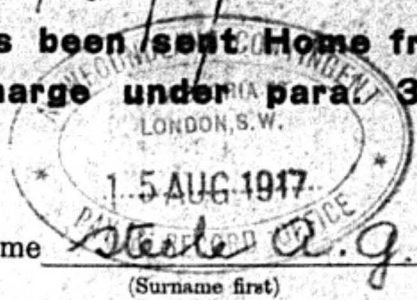

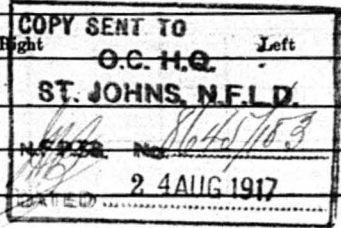

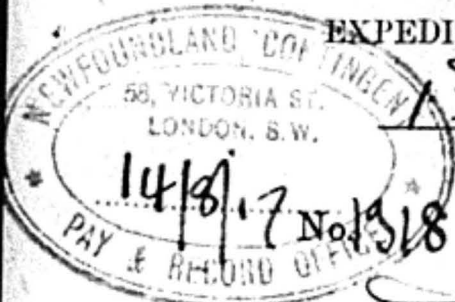
