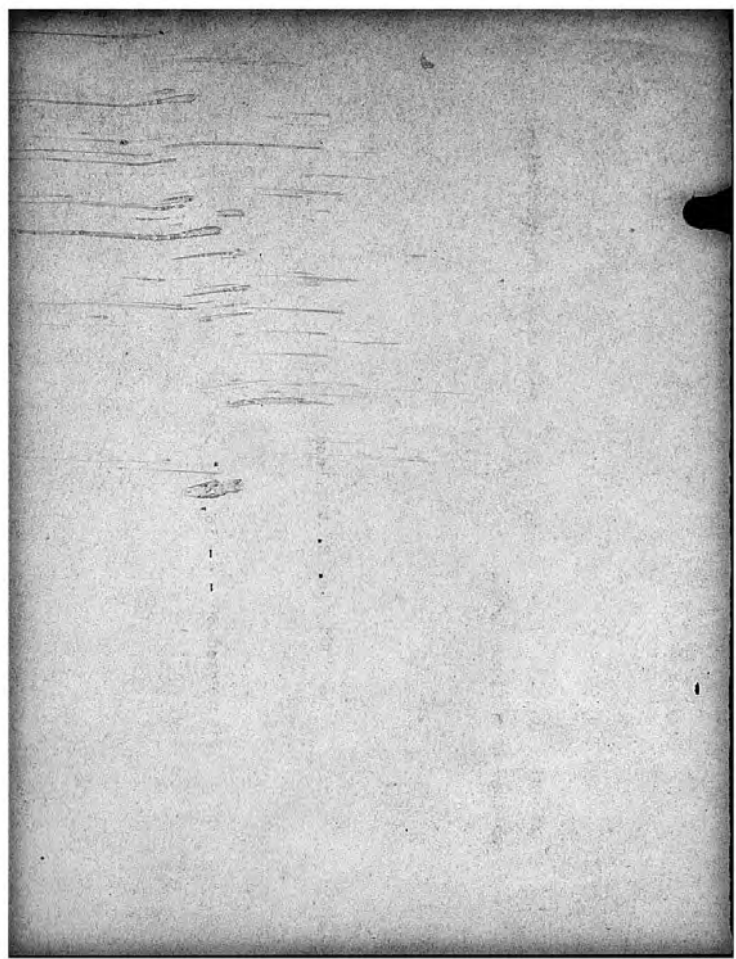

While in St Johns the other day is when at the Harmony looking for my sons Discharge Papers as I had meet you a day or two before on water Street and you told me to call up for them and they told me at the Harmony there was no Discharge for him on the books but Sergeant Hussy and others bringing me and also took his clothes back when you ordered him to do so and it is somewhat strange there was no Discharge Entered on the books for him after been Examined the second time and ordered him to bring his clothing back

My Son (no) was 1 thumb 48 0 4

Sergeant Hussy asked him would he have his paper or wait for a badge and he said he would rather have his badge if he could get one this is the reason he did not have his papers all they told me was on the book for him is on leave. there was another Strickland Discharged the same time and the Chapl considers it was a mistake this is Ed Strickland I am speaking of entered about April 30<sup>th</sup> the 5 of money you took his clothing from him and told him he was Discharged and told him he would get the badge later now Sir he is about to go north to the fishery the Customs says he needs his Papers or some signature before they will clear him you told me yourself Sir on Thursday last if there was any trouble to call you and you would rightify it I beg of you Sir to give this a consideration assure your obedient servant
