He returned to Duty the next day and has been on parade ever since. Yesterday he was granted Special Leave of absence without pay until November 15th to proceed to his home.

The Orderly Sergeant of his Company states that he understood from Private Sturge that the matter for which he had been sent down the Chief Clerk, Military Service Board, had ended.
