"This soldier appears in the film taken while Mr.Bennett "was in France. Part of that film depicts certain members of the Regiment being presented with their military decorations by the then Minister of Militia: and Thomas is noted in the list of names as "Thompson".

It will be noted that as the film "moves, in several of the pictures there is quite a space between him and the men on either side, which it is "thought would facilitate the making of a photograph "from the negative. 
