- (2) These facilities were placed explicitly at the disposal of the staff of the P.& R.O. by War Office letter 121/Overseas/2845, [F.1] of 17/10/16. (The contents of this letter will, presumably, have been conveyed to such men as may have joined the P.& R.O. staff subsequent to receipt of the letter.)
- (3) This information was published to the Staff of the P.&.R.O. in order 35A, dated December 31st.1916.

In view of the publicity given to the War Office letter, as far as the Staff of the P.& R.O. are concerned, it must be considered in the nature of a command that they avail themselves of the facilities afforded, unless unforseen circumstances preclude such a course; and, unless satisfactory explanation of their failure to so procure their dental treatment can be afforded, their claims cannot be considered and the expense must be borne by them individually.


