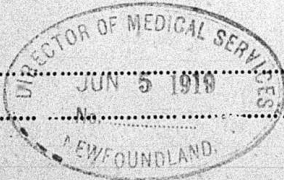

Dear Sir:-

I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your letter of Dec. 6th, in which you ask if your sons, No. 939, Private James Vardy and No. 3527, Corpl. Reuben Vardy can be repatriated at an early date.

It is hoped that as soon as possible all Newfoundland troops will be returned to this country. The work entailed in arranging for transportation, and preparation of the documents of these men, means that the Staff of the Pay & Record Office are working at high pressure. I am afraid that for the present the services of men in the Pay & Record Office, London could not easily be dispensed with without the work suffering considerably.

I trust, therefore, that you will be satisfied to wait a while longer before pressing for the return of your two boys, whose services are still required for military purposes



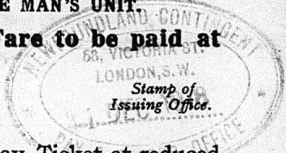
