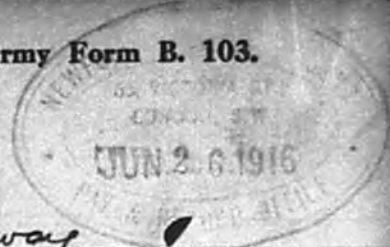

Notes.—(i.) 
