From the time the Draft List was made out their names were called out every day until the Draft sailed. E I made out passes for their Three days Home Leave. I was present when they received their Draft Pay. They returned from Home Leave and were on parade the day previous to the Draft sailing. The Draft sailed on the 29th. January. and Ptes. Avery and Voisey were marked absent.

When the list of the Draft was first made out I saw Voisey and Avery on parade and they answered to their names. 
