I am directed to inform you that a grave has been found in Knightsbridge Cemetery, which is about 1700 yards South-West of Beaumont Hamel, and 1500 yards North-West of Hamel, France, which bears a cross inscribed as follows:—

506 Cpl. G. E. WATT ?
 R. Newfoundland Rgt. 1.7.16.

These are apparently intended to be your late regimental particulars. No information has been obtained as to the identity of the soldier buried in this grave, but it is thought that he may have been in possession of some documents or equipment which belonged to you and this led to his being buried under your name.
