Madam,-

Referring to your letter 26/2/16, it would appear from your and other complaints that various parcels &c. sent to the 1st. Battalion from Newfoundland have not been delivered, but such may only be a question of delay which in many instances is doubtless unavoidable, although the care apparently taken by both the Army and Civil Postal/ services is from time to time in evidence.

Large quantities of mail matter are constantly passing through this Office, the process being to redirect to the last known whereabouts of addressee, when the Postal authorities again take charge. I also understand that considerable quantities have been sent direct from Newfoundland to the Mediterranean, this being evidenced by the fact of a number that are sent back to this Office for distribution.

With the volume of parcels and letters passing through it is naturally impracticable to record individual cases, unless sent by registered

post

post, when due records thereof are made. After mails are examined and redirected they are handed to the Postal authorities, and doubtless undergo various handlings, especially when addressees are moved from place to place, in hospitals, or otherwise; and also as there have probably been instances of mails lost at sea, losses in transit must be regarded as inevitable.

Your case seems a particularly regrettable one, but I fear that under the circumstances nothing can be done in the matter.
