The only people at his home are an aged mother and an invalid brother, Lazarus, aged 24 who is married. He is unable to do any work and his wife, at present, is very ill.

Elisha West works in St. John's and is married and has a family of 5 children and so can do very little to help support the mother and family.

Private Stephen West made an application for exemption but, on August 15th, it was disallowed. Elisha West states that the circumstances of the family are very hard and he wishes to know if Leave of absence, Without Pay, for ~~some~~ some time can be granted to his brother.
