I beg leave to make application for pay due to me, owing to my not taking leave to Nfld. from France in 1918. I reached London with the first 'Blue Funnel' craft, but missed my steamer for home. I reported next day to O.C. Troops, Winchester, and was informed I could stay in Winchester and await the next steamer or, as an alternative, return back to France. I decided on the latter course, and the following day reported back to the Regiment in France. I would be very grateful if you would consider this claim, and credit me with any amount that may be due.

I might add, I only had 24 days leave in 41 months continuous service, and think above claim should receive your just consideration. Thanking you in anticipation.


Dear Sir:

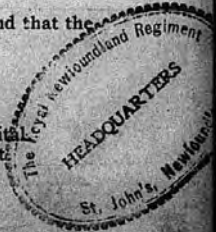
