TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The bearer, Sgt. William Willar, enlisted in the Royal Newfoundland Regiment in July, 1915, and proceeded Overseas on active service in October of that year. He has seen active service in France for twenty five months. Was once wounded, and returned here in August, 1918, for duty. Since the Armistice has been signed he has been posted for discharge. His record in the Regiment is one highly creditable, having been promoted from Private to the rank of Sergeant on recommendation of his Commanding Officer.

He proposes to again enter civil life and to take up the business of Sail-making in conjunction with his cousin, Mr. Arch Willar, and intends opening a Sail-making business on Holloway Street. I have, therefore, much pleasure in recommending him to the Trade for their liberal consideration, as I feel sure the work entrusted to him will be executed in the same manner which he performed his Military duties.



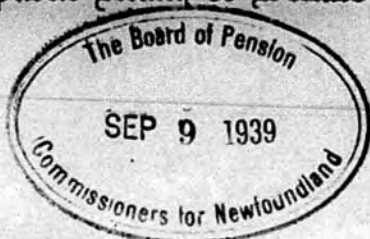

In consideration of having been granted leave of absence for the purpose of taking up civil employment, I agree to free the Royal Newfoundland Regiment from all claims and responsibilities (except as mentioned hereafter) on my behalf from this date, and during the period of such civil employment, until I receive my regular discharge from the Regiment, subject to receiving during the said period the ordinary pay of my present rank on the understanding that I forfeit field, subsistence and separation allowances, payable from this date.
