Dear Sir:

We are just in receipt of a letter under date February 18th from Mr. William J. White of Catalina. Mr. White says that his son, Corporal Albert C. White, No. 1374, of the Royal Newfoundland Regiment, was killed in action on the 14th day of April, 1917. About ten months after his son was killed he received the sum of \$144.00. Since that he has received nothing.

We give the following quotation from his letter:

"I have written to the Paymaster of the Army Headquarters in St. John's, Mr. Howley. I have also spoken to Mr. Stone and Mr. Halfyard, Colonial Secretary, but nothing come of it. I am only a poor man and need the money worse than some who are getting it."

We have no knowledge of the facts of this case except as they were written to us by Mr. White. We would appreciate the courtesy if you would have the matter investigated and communicate with Mr. White in that regard.

Dear Sir:

A few days ago Messrs. Squires & Winter wrote me in connection with your claim on account of your son, the late #1374 Cpl. Albert C. White, who was Killed in Action on the 14th of April, 1917. I referred the matter to the Paymaster, and received the following reply.

"#1374 Cpl. Albert C. White had an Allotment payable to his father, which was discontinued at his own request on the 31st January 1917. He was Killed in Action on the 14th April 1917. As soon as the account showing the balance due to his estate was received from London, the amount of One Hundred and Forty Dollars and Forty Four Cents (\$140.44) was paid to the Administrator, William J. White, Catalina. As there was no allotment current at the time of Cpl. White's decease, no further payments have been made on his account. The matter is now one for the Board of Pension Commissioners."

From the foregoing you will perceive that this terminates the payments as far as this Department is concerned. I must now refer you to the Board of Pension Commissioners, and, if you will write to Mr. C.C. Oke, Assistant Secretary of that Board, he would be able to give you all the necessary information in connection with this subject.

#1374 Corpl. Albert C. White had an Allotment payable to his father, which was discontinued at his own request on the 31st January 1917. He was "Killed in Action" on the 14th April 1917. As soon as the account showing the balance due to his estate was received from London, the amount of One hundred and forty dollars and forty-four cents (\$140.44) was paid to the Administrator, William J. White, Catalina. As there was no allotment current at the time of Corpl. White's decease, no further payments have been made on his account. The matter is now one for the Board of Pension Commissioners.
