

Admitted here on 31-3-18 with Connel's tubes in L. Elbow. On 7-4-18 Pl. was operated on three fingers being laid open for pins was found to be floating above forearm. The middle finger joint found to be present as well; cartilage of hand & radius then noted. The elbow became completely overgrown. The shoulder wounds gave no trouble & soon healed. They (2 in all) are situated in the scapular region.

Opinion of the Medical Board.

Notes.—(i.) Clear and decisive answers to the following questions are to be carefully filled in by the Board, as, in the event of the man being invalided, it is essential that the Minister of Pensions should be in possession of the most reliable information to enable him to decide upon the man's claim to pension.

- (ii.) Expressions such as "may," "might," "probably," &c., should be avoided.
