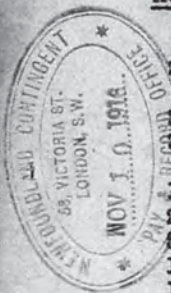

In conclusion I trust you will kindly favour me



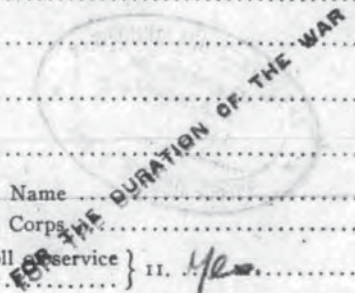
