In reply to your letter of the 29th ultimo, I desire to say that No. 3169, Private Samuel Woodland, was reported on the 17th October as having been admitted to the 2nd London General Hospital suffering from a compound fracture of the clavicle caused by gunshot wound. This information was communicated to Mr. Edward Woodland, Greenspond, who was named by Private Woodland, at the time of his enlistment, as his next of kin. No further report concerning him has since been received and I presume therefore that he is still at the above named hospital. Upon receipt of a reply to an enquiry concerning his condition, which I shall now make of the Pay and Record Office, London, I shall communicate with you.
